Skill Development Program-Lok Sevashram Chiksaura have organized skill development training program in different trades like Shorthand Typing, Food Processing, Beautician, Pumpset-Generater Repairing, Sewing-Cutting, Soft Toys Making, Motor Vehicle Driving, Fetter Welder, Carpentry, Production of Vermi Compost, MASHRUM PRODUCTION through NABARD in Chiksaura to Thirty women farmers of JIVIKA Groups. They awarded stipend and certificate .They also trained for MASHRUM PROCESSING and Marketing.



Catract Operation& Health Check-up Camp: The organization is also conducting free operation of cataract by collecting the donation. The beneficiaries of this camp are the poor people and vulnerable group of community; those cannot afford the cost of the operation. The organization is providing lance and medicine is also provided by the organization. The
