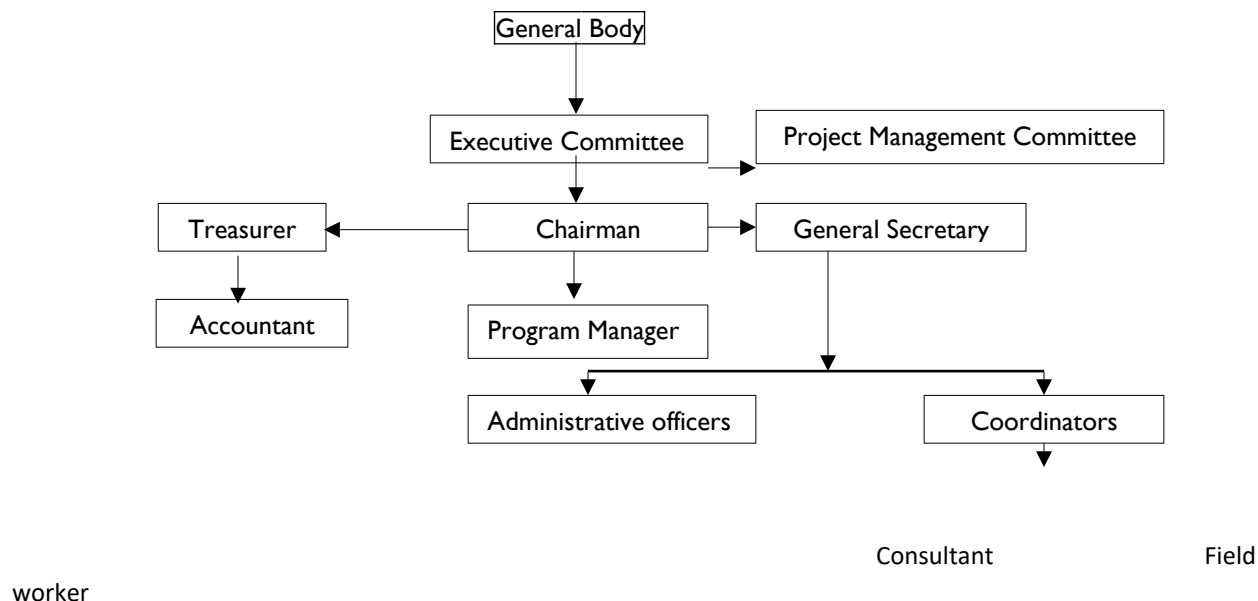
Our Management

Seminar- Organised seminar on right age marriage, Pregnancy delay and compulsory marriage registration for better health and to get benefits by government available for them. The organization also organized seminars on PCPNDT Act, Drinking water, Girl Health, Solar Energy, National Oil Seed, Climate change, Human rights, Bachan Bachao and Farmers Training, Right to Information Watershed Development, Science & Technology, Health & Sanitation, Flood Disaster and Rural Development.

FORMATION OF FPO -Development of Fisheries Farmers through organising Farmer Producer Organisation named "MATASYASHAY FISHERIES FARMER PRODUCER COMPANY PVT LTD" with support by "NABARD" till now two hundred and twenty five farmers are share holder partners managed by a dedicated Board of Directors. The company applied for Agriculture based Fertiliser, Seed and Insecticide shop which is running smoothly for our company share holders. The company organized for all the Fishery Farmers in Nalanda Distt.

Development of Minor and Landless Farmers – Our Organisation organized minor and landless farmers in Five Villages and organized them for group farming for cash crops like vegetable, Mushroom Cultivation etc. The minor and landless farmers do not have irrigation system and other resources to cultivate their land which they have. Our Organisation is trying

Skill Development Program-Lok Sevashram Chiksaura have organized skill development training program in different trades like Shorthand Typing, Food Processing, Beautician, Pumpset-Generator Repairing, Sewing-Cutting, Soft Toys Making, Motor Vehicle Driving, Fetter Welder, Carpentry, Production of Vermi Compost, Home Nursing Attendant and in different trades of Computer for rural & urban unemployed youths. Most of them are earning through their skills for families.



Cataract Operation & Health Check-up Camp: The organization is also conducting free operation of cataract by collecting the donation. The beneficiaries of this camp are the poor people and vulnerable group of community; those cannot afford the cost of the operation.
